Efforts are being made to align current legislation with these goals through initiatives such as Fit for 55, which aims to revise climate, energy, and transport-related laws in the EU. The aviation industry is also committed to meeting its own emissions reduction targets over the next three decades as highlighted in the industry initiative Destination 2050.
